Presenting its entire product portfolio in Business Aviation and Defence & Security, Piaggio Aerospace will showcase the Avanti EVO, one of the most sophisticated aircraft in its market segment, as well as a full scale model of the P.1HH HammerHead, a MALE

(Medium-Altitude Long-Endurance) class unmanned aircraft.

**Speaking from Le Bourget, Carlo Logli, Chief Executive Officer of Piaggio Aerospace**, said: "The International Paris Air Show comes at a particularly important stage for Piaggio Aerospace, following a comprehensive restructuring which saw us become a leaner business that is fully focused on its core areas of expertise."

Piaggio Aerospace has celebrated a number of key milestones in recent months that demonstrate the success of the organization's renewed focus and refreshed vision:

Deliveries of the **Avanti EVO**, the third generation of the iconic Piaggio Aerospace aircraft and the fastest turboprop aircraft, have begun

The MPA (Multirole Patrol Aircraft), a technologically-advanced, high-efficiency plane designed for maritime, coastal and ground patrols equipped for wide-range surveillance missions, is now at an advanced stage of its development and it is expected to perform its maiden flight by the end of this year.

The **P.1HH** HammerHead, designed for intelligence, surveillance and reconnaissance missions, is completing its flight test campaign and will be delivered to its launching customer – the Italian Air Force (ITAF) shortly. For the first time, the P.1HH HammerHead will be presented at Le Bourget with the livery of the ITAF 28° Stormo (flight formation), part of 32° Wing located in Amendola (Apulia region).
